We encourage disciples to seek out at least one opportunity each week to bless or serve others in their neighborhood, work, school, or everyday place. Here is a list of ideas to serve Jesus as you serve others.

- 1. Say a word of encouragement. Make it timely, specific, and simple. It could be something as simple as, "I can see you really love your kids and care about their well-being."
- 2. Ask people about their day and ask one follow-up question.
- 3. Mow a neighbor's lawn, rake their leaves, etc.
- 4. Take out a neighbor's trash or return their trash bins after trash day.
- 5. Take a neighbor, co-worker, or friend a baked good or treat just for them.
- 6. If a co-worker or neighbor has a new child or is experiencing a hard or stressful season, bring them a meal.
- 7. Bring your co-workers morning coffee, just because.
- 8. Offer to babysit for a neighbor or friend so they can go shopping, go on a date, or have some alone time.
- 9. Be considerate of those struggling in poverty or homelessness. Bring them warm drinks and ask them about their day.
